GARBAGE COLLECTION SERVICE GUIDELINES

- ♦ Have trash out and available **NO LATER THAN 7:00 A.M.**
- ♦ Trash should be placed in containers designed for residential trash, including trash cans with handles and/or bags.
- ♦ Containers should be of sufficient wall strength to hold contents *without breaking when lifted by handles or from the top of the bag.*
- ♦ Garbage cans should not exceed 35 gallon capacity or 50 lbs. when full (no 55-gallon drums).
- ♦ Although recycling is not provided with regular waste collection, citizens are encouraged to use local school bins for newspapers, magazines, and catalogs, and the Fort Bend Recycling Center for other recyclable items, 1200 Blume Road, phone: 281-633-7581,

COLLECTION OF TREE TRIMMINGS, CUTTINGS, LEAVES AND OTHER YARD WASTE

- ♦ There is no separate day for collection of tree trimmings, leaves and other yard waste; it will be collected with regular trash pick-up.
- ♦ Tree cuttings should be cut into 4-foot lengths, no larger than 3 inches in diameter, no bundling required; logs should be cut to firewood size.
- ♦ 50 lb limit per pick-up.

HEAVY TRASH PICK-UP

- ♦ Heavy trash (residential bulky waste\*) will be collected once weekly on your second regularly-scheduled collection day (Thursday or Friday).
- ♦ The following items are not accepted by Allied Waste for pick-up: items containing refrigerant (CFC's), television sets, car parts, whole tires, hazardous materials, construction debris, wet paint, motor oil, gas tanks, or other items which may become flammable when mixed with other garbage.

HOLIDAY COLLECTION SCHEDULE

Holiday collection schedules are published in the Fort Bend Herald immediately preceding each holiday.

Following are the six holidays on which there will be no garbage collection.

- ♦ *New Year's Day*
- ♦ *Memorial Day*
- ♦ *Independence Day*
- ♦ *Labor Day*
- ♦ *Thanksgiving Day*
- ♦ *Christmas Day*

If any of the above holidays fall on one of your regularly-scheduled garbage collection days, your garbage will be picked up on your next regularly-scheduled collection day.

\*RESIDENTIAL BULKY WASTE: Limit of one bulky item per pick-up to include: stoves, refrigerators (with Freon removed and properly tagged by an authorized technician), water heaters, washing machines, mattresses, furniture, and other waste materials (other than dead animals) with weights or volumes greater than those allowed for bins or containers. Carpeting will be picked up if cut to 4-foot width.
